The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman, Richard DeLong, Police Chief William McEllroy, Manager/Secretary/Treasurer Monica Flower, Assistant Secretary Margaret Wursta, Roadmaster Michael Quick and local residents. **AN EXECUTIVE SESSION WAS HELD ON THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 4, 2025
AT 2:30PM, TO DISCUSS PERSONNEL**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 3:04 P.M. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

General Discussion:

- Gene Schappell presented the opportunity to enter an agreement with the Patriotic Order Sons of America (POSA), for the yearly maintenance of the Monument along Hex Highway in front of the Tilden Elementary school. The Township would be responsible for digging the area around the Monument for the POSA to place a border, landscape fabric and stone. The cost of these items would be the responsibility of the Township. The Township will also need to repair the cement and brick, and replace the small flags flown as needed. The POSA will donate one American flag per year and provide maintenance of the site.

A Motion was made by Gene Schappell and seconded by Richard DeLong to enter an agreement with the Patriotic Sons of America (PSOA), to maintain the Monument along Hex Highway in front of the Tilden Elementary School. Upon roll call Schppell, Herman and DeLong voted yes.

- The Supervisors and Township Manager Monica Flower resumed the Zoning Ordinance Draft with definitions E - L, stopping at Livestock.
