## **ORDINANCE NO.** 126 , 1999

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 63 OF 1987, AS AMENDED, REGULATING TRAFFIC AND PARKING IN THE TOWNSHIP, TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON CERTAIN SECTIONS OF BERNE ROAD

WHEREAS, the Township of Tilden, Berks County, Pennsylvania (the "Township") dopted Ordinance No. 63 of 1987, as amended by Ordinances 65-1987, 69-1988, 87-1991, 92-1993, 93-1993, 98-1998, 102-1994, 106-1995, 109-1996, 116-1997 and 124-1999, regulating traffic and parking in the Township (collectively, the "Traffic and Parking Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Township now desires to amend the Traffic and Parking Ordinance by amending and/or supplementing Article III, Section 1 pertaining to prohibitions against parking, stopping and standing at all times in certain locations along roads within the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Tilden, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. of Section 1, entitled "Parking, Stopping and Standing Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations", of Article III, entitled "Parking Regulations", of the Traffic and Parking Ordinance is hereby amended in its entirety so as to hereafter read as follows:

"Section 1. Parking, Stopping and Standing Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations. Parking, stopping and standing shall be prohibited at all times in the following locations:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
Berne Road	North	Intersection of Fisher Dam Road (T-558) and Berne Road (T-811) to a point 865 feet northwardly thereof
Industrial Drive	East and West	The railroad crossing, west of the intersection of Lowland Road and Industrial Drive, to and including the cul-de-sac (located in the Tilden Industrial Park)

Jetson Drive

North and South

Intersection of Jetson Drive and

Industrial Drive to intersection of

Jetson Drive and S.R. 61

West State Street South

Intersection of the centerline of Hill Drive and West State Street to a point 175 feet westwardly

thereof"

Section 2. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Tilden Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 3. All prior ordinances of the Township of Tilden, insofar as they deal with the regulation of maximum speed limits are repealed and declared unenforceable insofar as they are inconsistent with or identical to any provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its enactment.
