

ORDINANCE NO. 132, 2001

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE SEWER USE ORDINANCE, NO. 103 OF 1994, TO REVISE SECTION 302, PROHIBITIVE DISCHARGES, TO COMPLY WITH STANDARDS, AS RECENTLY PUBLISHED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND AS ADOPTED BY THE HAMBURG MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY, AND PROVIDING THAT FUTURE CHANGES IN ALLOWABLE LIMITS FOR DISCHARGES AND AMENDMENTS TO FEDERAL CATEGORICAL PRETREATMENT STANDARDS BE ADOPTED AND ENFORCED BY THE TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION, PUBLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW, WHICH MAY BE ADOPTED FROM TIME TO TIME AS REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA OR THE HAMBURG MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY, AS APPLICABLE FROM TIME TO TIME.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED as follows:

Section 1. Section 302 of Ordinance 103 of 1994 be and hereby is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 302(d)(7):

Section 2. Section 302 of Ordinance No. 103 is further amended as follows:

(g) The standards as set forth above for prohibited discharges may be amended by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the Township, from time to time, as required by federal, state, or local regulations, and any requirements as may be lawfully imposed pursuant to agreement with the Hamburg Municipal Authority.


Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.


Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any of its provisions, paragraphs, words, sections, articles, terms or clauses are for any reason declared invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, such invalidity, illegality or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, paragraphs, words, sections, articles, terms and clauses of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Tilden that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such invalid, illegal or unconstitutional provisions not been included herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days following enactment by the Board of Supervisors of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania




