ORDINANCE NO. <u>/7/, 2006</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN, **BERKS** COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, **AMENDING** SECTION 403, ENTITLED "IMPOSITION OF TAX", OF PART 4, ENTITLED "EMERGENCY AND MUNICIPAL **SERVICES** TAX" OF CHAPTER XXIX, ENTITLED "TAXATION, SPECIAL" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN INCREASING THE EMERGENCY AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES TAX ON PERSONS ENGAGED IN ANY OCCUPATION WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP FROM \$30.00 TO \$52.00 EFFECTIVE **JANUARY 1, 2007**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Tilden, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 403, entitled "Imposition of Tax", of Part 4 entitled "Emergency and Municipal Services Tax" of Chapter XXIX, entitled "Taxation, Special", of the Code of Ordinances of the Township of Tilden is hereby amended and restated in its entirety so as to hereafter read as follows:

Section 403. Imposition of Tax. A tax for police, fire and emergency services, road construction and/or maintenance; or reduction of property taxes, in the amount of Fifty-Two Dollars and 00/100 Dollars (\$52.00), is hereby imposed upon the privilege of engaging in an occupation within the Township of Tilden, Berks County, Pennsylvania, in the year 2007 after the effective date of this Part, and in each following calendar year. Each natural person who exercises such privilege for any length of time in any calendar year beginning with the year 2007, after the effective date of this Part, shall pay the tax in accordance with the provisions hereof; provided the tax hereby levied shall not be imposed upon any natural person whose total income during the taxable year is any figure less than or equal to Twelve Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$12,000).

<u>Section 2</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.

The Code of Ordinances of the Township of Tilden, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as amended, shall be and remain unchanged and in full force and effect except as amended, supplemented and modified by this Ordinance. This Ordinance shall become a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Township of Tilden, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as amended, upon adoption.
