## ORDINANCE NO. 2/3\_-2012

AN ORDINANCE OF TILDEN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING PART 2 ENTITLED "TRAFFIC REGULATIONS", OF CHAPTER XIX ENTITLED "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" OF THE TILDEN TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ESTABLISH OR RATIFY OFFICIAL TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF ROUTE 61 AND ROUTE 78 WESTBOUND, ROUTE 61 AND ROUTE 78 EASTBOUND, ROUTE 61 AND JESTON DRIVE, CABELAS DRIVE AND MOUNTAIN ROAD, ROUTE 61 AND LOWLAND ROAD, AND WEST STATE STREET AND INDUSTRIAL DRIVE

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Part 2 entitled "Traffic Regulations", of Chapter XIX entitled "Motor Vehicles and Traffic", of the Code of Ordinances of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, is hereby supplemented by adding thereto the following Section 205:

"Section 205. Traffic Signals at Certain Intersections. At the following intersections, official traffic signals shall be erected, or if up until now have already been erected are ratified, and traffic at such intersections shall be directed by such traffic signals:

Route 61 & Route 78 westbound Route 61 & Route 78 eastbound Route 61 & Jetson Drive Cabela Drive & Mountain Road Route 61 & Lowland Road West State Street & Industrial Drive

Any operator of a vehicle who shall disobey the directions of a traffic signal shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, be sentenced to imprisonment for a number of days equal to one (1) day for each Ten Dollars (\$10.00) of unpaid balance of fine and costs."

Section 2. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or

invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Tilden Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the law.

Section 5. The Code of Ordinances of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as amended, shall be and remain unchanged and in full force and effect except as amended, supplemented and modified by this Ordinance. This Ordinance shall become a part of the Code of Ordinances of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as amended, upon adoption.

SECTION 6. It is declared that enactment of this Ordinance is necessary for the protection, benefit and preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of this Township.
