## ordinance no. <u>35</u> , 1974

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN AMENDING A PREVIOUS ORDINANCE, BEING ORDINANCE NO.6 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN WHEREBY THE TOWNSHIP PLAN-NING COMMISSION WAS CREATED AND ESTABLISHED.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Tilden hereby amends Ordinance No.6 enacted and ordained as an Ordinance on May 5, 1965, as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section 2 of the aforesaid Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

> "SECTION 2 - All members of the Planning Commission shall reside within the Township of Tilden and shall serve without compensation. At least three members of such Commission shall be citizens who do not hold other public offices, either elected or appointed, within the Township. Any member shall be subject to removal by the Board of Supervisors after a public hearing for inefficiency, neglect of duty or malfeasance in office.

SECTION 2 - In all other respects the Ordinance as originally adopted remains in full force and effect.
