

ORDINANCE NO. 6, 1965

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN CREATING
AND ESTABLISHING A TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Tilden hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1 - A Township Planning Commission consisting of five (5) members to be appointed by the Township Supervisors is hereby created and established. At the first appointment one member shall be appointed to serve for one year, one for two years, one for three years, one for four years and one for five years. Upon the expiration of each of the said terms and of any term thereafter, the Township Supervisors shall make an appointment for a term of five years. An appointment to fill any other vacancy shall be only for the unexpired portion of the term.

SECTION 2 - All members of the Planning Commission shall reside within the Township of Tilden, shall serve without compensation, and shall hold no other Township office except that of member of the Township Zoning Commission or the Township Zoning Board of Adjustment. Any member shall be subject to removal by the Board of Supervisors after a public hearing for inefficiency, neglect of duty or malfeasance in office.

SECTION 3 - The Planning Commission shall organize as provided in the Second Class Township Code, and shall have such powers and be subject to such duties as are prescribed therein.

The Planning Commission or its employees may, while performing necessary work, enter upon any land in order to examine or survey it or to place and maintain necessary temporary markers thereon.
