

ORDINANCE NO. 64, 1987

THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED BY THE BOARD
OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 68 of 1985 setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class, and

WHEREAS, said Act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of not more than four thousand nine hundred ninety-nine (4,999) shall be compensated in an amount not to exceed Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500) per year, and

WHEREAS, the population of Tilden Township is approximately two thousand two hundred (2,200), and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly by Act 68 authorizes the boards of supervisors of the various townships of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations as set forth in the Act, and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Tilden Township to set compensation for the Supervisors on a per meeting basis and within the limitations of Act 68,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

1. Each Supervisor of Tilden Township elected or appointed to office on or after the effective date of the Act of the General Assembly Number 68 of 1985, shall receive compensation

for attending duly advertised general or special public meetings of the Board of Supervisors at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) for each meeting attended by such Supervisor beginning with the January 4, 1988, regular meeting of the Board.

2. No Supervisor shall receive annual compensation under this Ordinance in excess of the annual statutory limit set by the General Assembly in Act 68 for supervisors of townships within the appropriate calculation category.

3. No Supervisor shall be compensated for attending any meetings of the Board of Supervisors in excess of thirty (30) meetings per year; such absences of compensation shall not negate or in any way effect such Supervisor's duty or obligation to attend such uncompensated meetings.

4. Such compensation shall be paid in monthly installments.

5. All prior ordinances of the Township of Tilden, insofar as they deal with matters contained herein, are repealed and declared unenforceable insofar as they are inconsistent with or identical to any provision of this Ordinance.

6. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after the date of adoption.


