

ORDINANCE NO. 65, 1988

Ordinance No. 63 of 1987 is amended to include as Article II, Section 2, as set forth below:

Section 2. Vehicle Weight Limits Established on Certain Streets and Bridges.

(a) On the following bridges and streets or parts of streets, by authority granted by Section 4902(a) of the Vehicle Code, it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to drive any vehicle or combination having a gross weight in excess of the maximum prescribed below for that bridge or street or part of street, as the case may be, except in instances of bona fide local deliveries.

<u>Street or Bridge</u>	<u>Relevant Portion</u>	<u>Maximum Gross Weight</u>
1. Laurel Avenue	Entire Length	10,000 lbs.

(b) Any person who violates any provision of this section shall be prosecuted under Sections 4902(a) and 4902(g-1) of the Vehicle Code, and, upon conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$150 plus \$150 for each 500 pounds, or part thereof, in excess of 3,000 pounds over the maximum allowable weight, and costs.
