ORDINANCE NO. 81, 1990

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING AND EMPOWERING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS OF THE TOWNSHIP TO ENTER INTO ON BEHALF OF THE TOWNSHIP AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF WHICH THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE WILL PROVIDE POLICE PROTECTION AND SERVICES TO THE TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, the Township of Centre has offered to provide police protection and services to the Township of Tilden pursuant to the terms of an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement between the Township of Centre and the Township of Tilden; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Tilden and the Township of Centre have both determined that there is a need for uniform enforcement of laws and ordinances throughout their respective territories, which are contiguous, the Township of Tilden being contiguous to the Township of Centre;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. The Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement by and between the Township of Centre and the township of Tilden, pursuant to the terms of which the Township of Centre agrees to provide police protection and services specified in the said

Agreement to the Township of Tilden, in the form presented to the Supervisors of the Township of Tilden, is hereby approved; and the appropriate officials of the Township of Tilden are hereby authorized and empowered to execute, acknowledge and deliver the said Agreement and any renewal Agreements on behalf of the Township of Tilden.

Section II. The Township of Tilden hereby delegates, transfers and assigns to the Township of Centre the power and authority of the Township of Tilden to provide police protection and services as specified in the said Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement within the boundaries of the Township of Tilden. The Police Officers of the Township of Centre providing such police protection and services within the boundaries of the Township of Tilden shall be under the exclusive supervision and control of the Township of Centre, acting through its Chief of Police.

Section III. The Township of Tilden shall appoint by resolution of the Supervisors an individual to act as a liaison with the Township of Centre and its Chief of Police concerning all matters arising under the terms of the aforesaid Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement between the Township of Centre and the Township of Tilden. If required, the Township of Tilden shall also appoint by resolution of the Supervisors an individual resident or individual residents of the Township of Tilden to serve on a committee composed of persons designated by the Township of Tilden and the Township of Centre for the

purpose of resolving any problems and disagreements between the parties concerning all matters arising under the terms of the aforesaid Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement.

Section IV. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately or the earliest date allowed by law.


