Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman; Chief William McEllroy; Manager/Treasurer/Secretary Monica Flower and Road Master Michael Quick and local residents. Absent: Supervisor Richard DeLong. The attendance roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 9:20 a.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Participation: None

General Discussion:

- The International Fire Code adopted in Ordinance 199-2009 was discussed to amend the ordinance to the 2021 Code. Further discussion will be held at the regular meeting with Chief Emes of the Hamburg Fire Dept.
- Supervisor Herman has received complaints of excessive smoke and burning after the allowed time of 9:00pm in the area of Berne Road and Hex Highway. The Ordinances pertaining to burning were discussed in great length. Suggested amendments are to restrict outdoor burning in the R-3 and R-4 to only allow outdoor burning for cooking, heating and ornamental. There will be further discussion at the regular meeting.
- A lean to for the top garage was discussed for storing equipment
- Water rate increase to \$7.00/1,000 gals was discussed. Further discussion and vote will be at the December meeting.

A Motion was made by Fred Herman and seconded by Gene Schappell to adjourn the meeting at 10:10 a.m. Upon roll call Schappell and Herman voted yes.
