Workshop & Budget Meeting

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building for the purpose of preparing the 2025 budget, with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman, and Richard DeLong; Police Chief William McEllroy, Manager/Secretary/Treasurer Monica Flower, Roadmaster Michael Quick, Assistant Secretary Margaret Wursta and local residents. The attendance roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 4:05 P.M. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Treasurer gave a brief statement of explanation regarding the process in developing the 2025 budget. Various line items discussed. A preliminary budget will be presented at the November board of supervisors regular meeting.

A Motion was made by Gene Schappell and seconded by Fred Herman to create a Capital Reserve account for Police Radio upgrades with \$15,000 budgeted each year beginning 2025. Upon roll call Schappell, Herman, and DeLong voted yes.
