ORDINANCE NO. 249-2022

AN AMENDATORY ORDINANCE OF TILDEN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF TILDEN TOWNSHIP, CHAPTER XIX, TITLED "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," PART 2, TITLED "TRAFFIC REGULATIONS," SECTION 201, TITLED "MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS," TO ADD THAT A PORTION OF BERNE ROAD (T-811) BETWEEN HEX HIGHWAY, OLD ROUTE 22 (SR 4028) AND A POINT 0.85 MILES SOUTH OF SR 4028 SHALL CONTINUE TO HAVE A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF THIRTY MILES PER HOUR (30 MPH); THAT THE REMAINDER OF BERNE ROAD TO THE BOUNDARY WITH CENTRE TOWNSHIP SHALL HAVE A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF FORTY MILES PER HOUR (40 MPH); THAT SIGNAGE INDICATING THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS SHALL BE ERECTED; THAT ALL EXISTING SIGNS ALONG BERNE ROAD ARE HEREBY RATIFIED AND CONFIRMED; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALER, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. Amendment to Maximum Speed Limits. The Code of Ordinances of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania Chapter XIX, titled "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," Part 2, titled "Traffic Regulations," Section 201, titled "Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Highways," Section (a)(3), relating to Berne Road (T-811) shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 201. Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Highways.

(a) Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specific highways as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any part of a highway where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the highway.

3. Berne Road (T-811)	Hex Highway, Old Rte. 22 (SR 4028) and a point 0.85 miles south of SR 4028	30 mph

Remainder from the point 0.85 miles south of SR 4028 to the boundary with Centre Township, Berks County 40 mph

Section 2. Signage. Signs indicating the above maximum speed limits shall be erected and placed in accordance with applicable Township and state regulations. All signs currently in place as of the date of this Ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. Full Force and Effect of Remaining Ordinances. The Ordinances of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, shall be and remain unchanged and in full force and effect except as amended, supplemented or modified by this Ordinance. This Ordinance shall become a part of the Ordinances of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, upon adoption.

Section 4. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, legality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Township Board of Supervisors that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Effective Date This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date permitted by law.
