

TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORSThursday, March 6, 2025
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman, Richard DeLong, Police Chief William McEllroy, Manager/Secretary/Treasurer Monica Flower, Assistant Secretary Margaret Wursta, Roadmaster Michael Quick, and local residents. The attendance roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 3:03 P.M. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

General Discussion:

- Mike Quick briefly reviewed the 2025 Road Project. He specified the two sections of Mountain Road that are to be paved. Gene Schappell expressed his concerns with the current condition of the road and reiterates his support for this project.
- The Supervisors discussed a plan to review the Zoning Ordinance Draft Amendment. Supervisors will submit all comments to Monica Flower. Monica will compile those comments into a list for further group discussion.
- Richard DeLong would like to discuss the township's ability to pay off the remaining sewer expansion loan as the balance of the sewer account can support this payoff. Once the loan is paid off, Richard would like to discuss the possibility of lowering the resident's quarterly sewer bills.
- Monica asked Richard if there are any updates from the Fire Department. Richard did not have anything specific to report. However, any questions from the Supervisors can be addressed at the next Fire Department's meeting.
- Monica will be inviting Leslie Herring to a future workshop meeting for a discussion with the Supervisors relating the EMS budget.
